Recently, I was invited to testify at the Status of Women Committee in the House of Commons regarding the impact Covid19 has had on women.

I am the only nominee to have served on the Saint Boniface Saint Vital Conservative Party of Canada Electoral District Association, showing my commitment to the riding.

I am an Intelligence Analyst/Officer having been trained at the Canadian Police College. I was seconded to the Criminal Intelligence Service Manitoba. My portfolios included gangs, organized crime and trafficking of illicit firearms.

With my experience on gangs and organized crime, I became an advocate and advisor for organizations, government and not-for-profit agencies to prevent at-risk youth from entering gang life.

I have real experience in developing public policy having worked in the Organizational and Development, Strategic Initiatives Unit for the Winnipeg Police Service.

I have a passion to be the voice for those without one. Those who are marginalized, homeless and fall prey to criminals. I am currently working on the frontline in one of the busiest and most violent areas of the city if not in Canada.

I am proud to have participated on a steering committee of 34 community and government leaders to develop a strategy to end gender-based homelessness in Winnipeg. A first of its kind in Manitoba, and believed to be in Canada.
